

Honorable _____ County Commissioners:

As a law-abiding resident of _____ County, I would like to submit the attached resolution in support of the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States. I feel that current state law infringes substantially on our rights. I ask that you, our elected representatives, consider this resolution for a vote. The resolution's intent is to send a message to Trenton that rights of law-abiding people in New Jersey are under attack.

Firearms legislation in New Jersey is extremely complex, and burdens the law-abiding more than criminals. Our current permitting system was founded in 1966, and intended to separate the fit from the unfit and the law-abiding from criminal. State law requires each applicant to prove they are "law-abiding". This burden of proof is satisfied by obtaining a firearms ID. However, additional state laws and local procedures impose more steps to meet a greater burden of proof. This imposes an unfair burden on law-abiding applicants, because criminals do not follow the law.

The resolution is based on case law. In no way does it make anyone immune from past or present firearms laws (see Section E.)
